Angelo J. Stagnaro Jr., 81, passed away peacefully at his home, surrounded by family, on Sunday, April 19, after a brief battle with cancer.

Angelo was born in San Francisco, on October 25, 1933, to two loving parents, Angelo and Anita (Franzoni) Stagnaro, Sr. Growing up in the Excelsior District, he attended neighborhood public schools and graduated from Balboa High School. Angelo was an extremely strong, kind and quick-witted man, who was known for his great patience and wisdom. He enjoyed dining and socializing with lifelong friends, traveling the world with his wife, and taking care of his "baby" a 1995 brown, Brougham Cadillac. He was a lifelong member of the Elks Club and served over 30 years as secretary of the Florist Club. Angelo was
