Carlos Ramirez Sr. was born to Wenceslao Ramirez and Antonia Daz Ramirez in Santo Tomas, La Union, Philippines on April 19, 1919 and passed away peacefully surrounded by his loving family on October 14, 2016 in Clovis, California at the age of 97.

Mr. Ramirez immigrated to the United States and proudly served in the United States Army. He was a decorated WWII POW and highly respected veteran. Carlos received countless awards and recognition honoring his service to our country. His bravery and dedicated service earned him a Purple Heart Medal and received a certificate of recognition from Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi. Upon his retirement from the Army as Sergeant First Class, Carlos continued to work for the U.S. Government in the civil service. He had a deep devotion to his Catholic faith and prayed daily.

Carlos is preceded in death by his wife Marta P. Ramirez in 1997 and his children, Virginia Waldon and Romeo Ramirez.
