Carmen Jimenez Dominguez lived life well, and on her own terms. Born in San Francisco in 1930, a graduate of Lick Wilmerding, UC Berkeley, and University of San Francisco Law School, she was a woman ahead of her time. She started her own law practice in the Mission District where she served clients in English and Spanish for 49 years. She also served the community as a member of the San Francisco Recreation and Park Commission, the Fair Employment Practice Advisory Committee on Californians of Spanish Surnames, and the St. Mary's Hospital and Medical Center Community Board. She was a proud and active member of Union Espanola for 50 years, of the Native Daughters of the Golden West, of the Bar Association of San Francisco and of the State Bar of California.

Carmen was adored and respected by her late husband, Joseph Dominguez, her late parents, Frank and Annie Jimenez, by her sister Mary and brother-in-law Humberto Vina, both deceased, and by her late brother, Frank Jimenez. She is survived and sorely missed by her nieces, Lynn Jimenez Catchings (John), Denise Jimenez Adams (George), and her grand nephew Cody Jimenez Adams. She is mourned also by her nieces Phyllis Ferris, Diane Macieik, and grand niece Amanda Macieik.
