David George Nevarez, 58, of San Francisco, California peacefully entered into our Fathers Kingdom on August 03, 2014. He was born on January 24, 1956 to parents George and Alicia I. Nevarez. He attended St. Peter's elementary and graduated from Sacred Heart in 1974. He then attended SF State where he became an activist in the Chicano/La Raza Movement and helped bring about change in the university's programs. At the age of 19 David married Alicia K. Venegas, together they had 3 children, David Gabriel Tlaloc, Jesus Jorge and Alicia Marie. Later in life he had his 4th child David Nevarez Waynes. Shortly after he met his beloved wife Carrey Ann, they married in July 2009. As a Mission District native, David will most be remembered for his passion in music, most notably the Congas, and Chicano culture. He was most proud of being a loving husband, father, and grandfather and his work as an IBEW electrician. He is survived by his wife Carrey Ann, son David Gabriel Tlaloc, grandchildren Gabriella Alicia (4yrs 10mo.), David Gabriel Tlaloc Jr (2yrs 7mo.), son Jesus Jorge, daughter-in-law Christine Marie, grandchildren Gemma Marie Xochi (2yrs 11mo.), Marco Joaquin Tonantih (15mo.), daughter Alicia Marie, son-in-law Joey Rios, grandchildren Gianna "Superstar" Alicia Rios (4yrs 9mo.), baby Rios Due November 18th, and son David Nevarez Waynes. 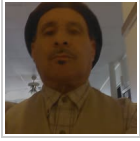

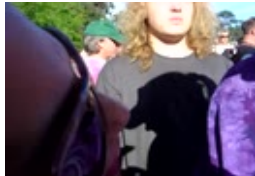

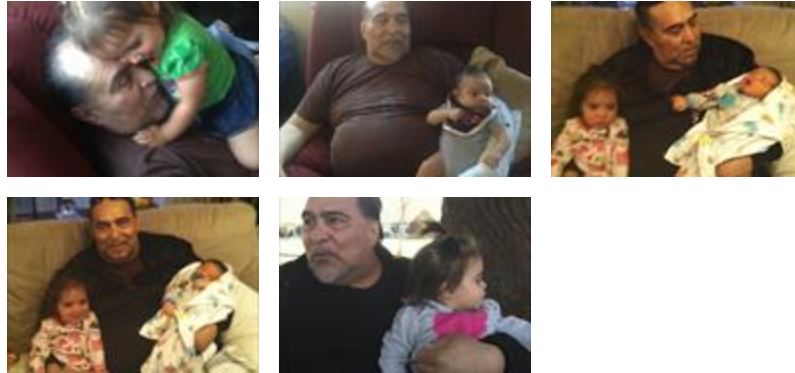
