February 9, 1905 - October 15, 2008

At rest in Point Reyes Station on October 15, 2008 at the age of 103. Born in San Francisco on February 9, 1905 to the late Antonio Vattuone and Caterina Demartini Vattuone, Della was the loving wife of the late Albert H. Bacchini; beloved mother of Nell Sullivan Van Becker and James Anthony Sullivan; cherished grandmother of Leslie and Antonia Van Becker and the late Stephen Van Becker; great grandmother of Matthew and Genevieve Clifford and Nicole and Marika Lee; sister of the late Antonio, Dominic, Evor, Mario, Armand and Dante Vattuone. Della lived in San Francisco at the time of the Great Earthquake of 1906 and was honored at the 100th Anniversary survivors celebration. From 2000 to 2007, she lived in Nicasio, Marin County, California, with her daughter, son-in-law, granddaughter, grandson-in-law and two great-granddaughters. At the time of her death on October 15, 2008, Della was living at Stockstill House at Point Reyes Station.
