



Mr. Louis Deghi

November 17, 1916 - April 9, 2013

Louis passed away on April 9th at Sutter Hospital in Santa Rosa with members of his family by his side. He was 96 years old. He was born November 17, 1916 in the town of Elk (Mendocino County) to Vincenzo and Aladina Deghi. He moved with his family to Italy in 1920, then came back by himself, arriving in New York City in 1934. From there he made his way to San Francisco and in 1939 married Mina Martinelli. Louis served two years in the U.S. Army during World War II. After returning from his service to the country he went to work as a cement mason and later retired from the Plasterers' and Cement Masons' Local 300.

He is predeceased by his wife of 57 years. Survived by sister Bruna Fantozzi, son Ron Deghi (Donna), daughter Angie Giannini (Ken), grandchildren JoAnn, Treana, Laura, Christina and Dana, and many great-grandchildren, nieces and nephews.
