While in the Phillipines, he attained a masters degree from University of the Philippines (MMgt). Norman left the U.S. Air Force in the Philippines soon after the eruption of Mount Pinatubo and moved back to the San Francisco Bay Area. In 2002 he met his wife of 12 years, Wai Ching Kwan. Norman and Wai Ching raised their son in the San Francisco Bay Area. Norman was an accomplished software engineer and leader. He worked in technology for over 20 years.
