



Mr. Pete Gamboa Santos

August 13, 1934 - September 16, 2015

Agapito "Pete" Gamboa Santos died of congestive heart failure on Wednesday, September 16, 2015 at Kaiser Permanente Hospital in South San Francisco. He was 81 years old. He was born on August 13, 1934 in Jabson Estate, Sumilang Pasig Rizal, Philippines. His parents were Fernando Beroya Santos and Eutiquia Gamboa Santos. He was the youngest child of eleven children.

Agapito attended Rizal High School and married Eliseria Garganta Moreno at Immaculate Conception Church on September 26, 1955. He was a certified welder for 19 years for Schrader Iron Works until he became disabled in 1986 and a member of The International Association of Bridge, Structural, Ornamental and Reinforcing Iron Workers Union, AFL-CIO until his death. Agapito moved to San Francisco on May 24, 1967 and never stopped thinking about his hometown, Sumilang where he had lived for 33 years. Agapito was known as a well dressed, humorous, generous, witty, and friendly person. He enjoyed life: dancing, music (piano and drums), traveling, and horses.

Agapito is survived by his loving wife, Eliseria Moreno Santos, his children Joselito Moreno Santos, Evelyn Santos Marcant, and Evangeline Moreno Santos-Ong, and grandchildren, Anthony Francois Marcant, Emmanuel Christophe Marcant, Matthew Julien Marcant, Kyle Alexander Ong, and Kevin Christopher Ong.

The services will be held at Valente, Marini, Perata & Company (4840 Mission Street, San Francisco, California) on Saturday, September 20 (5-9p), Sunday, September 21 (9-9p; 7:00p Rosary), and Monday, September 22 (9a-10a). Catholic church services is on Monday, September 22 at 10:00am at Corpuz Christi, 62 Santa Rosa Avenue, San Francisco California, followed by his internment at the Italian Cemetery in Colma.
