July 29, 1922 - January 13, 2017

Rosario Pabello Albert (Rose/Sayong), was born on July 29, 1922 and died peacefully at home on January 13, 2017 at the age of 94. She was born in Mina-anting, Samar, Philippines, one of 12 siblings. She married U.S. Army Staff Sergeant Dennis Albert on June 23, 1945, in Catarman, Philippines, during the middle of World War II. Their first daughter Anna May was born in 1946 in Samar, Philippines. As a War Bride, Rose and her daughter arrived by Army Transport, USS General R.M. Blatchford, at Fort Mason, San Francisco on June 6, 1947. Their second daughter Mae Rose was born in San Francisco in 1948. Rose was employed for over 40 years. As a recent immigrant, her first job was as a waitress on Kearny Street in SF's Manilatown, followed by obtaining her Licensed Practical Nurse Certification. She ultimately retired as a keypunch operator for Civil Service Employees Insurance Company. She traveled extensively/internationally, loved bringing people to and walking along Ocean Beach, and faithfully watched KQED, Jeopardy, Wheel of Fortune, and The Oprah Winfrey Show. She is survived by her two daughters Anna May Pettis (James) and Mae Rose; grandchildren Mark Grafilo, Dean Grafilo (Marisa), and Reanna (Ronnie); Great grandchildren Lauren (Roxanne), Tamlyn, Miles, Lizelle, and Sehana; one brother Faustino; and numerous nieces and nephews.
